Description

The original silk damask is faded and worn and elevates the status of this vernacular corner cupboard. The silk damask would have had a considerably higher value than the corner cupboard itself. It suggests that this piece was used for storing textiles

The highly decorative original iron hinges are typically characteristic features of Spanish furniture

Exudes the character and charm of Spanish furniture

The doors upholstered with the original, crimson silk damask and striking wrought iron oak leaf hinges. The interior fitted with two shelves.
